Cushman After School Club Policies

1. All clubs are on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is a limited amount of space in many clubs. Get your application in early.
2. Registration must be accompanied with the club tuition, supply fee and application fee in order to be enrolled.
3. Only one application fee is required per student regardless of the number of clubs he or she is attending in any club session.
4. Students must be enrolled by the first week (first day) of the club. Students registering after the deadline date may not be able to attend the first class.
5. Students registering after the due date will be charged a \$10.00 late fee.
6. If a student doesn't wish to continue to attend a club after the first meeting, he or she is entitled to a refund of TUITION only. Written notice must be submitted within two days after the first meeting or a refund will not be given.
7. Teachers will make up any club meetings they miss for days the school is closed or if the teacher is out of school. If the student misses a meeting, the teacher is not required to make up that day. If a student is absent from school on the day a club meets, they may not attend the club that day.
8. Students must be picked up promptly when clubs are finished or they will be sent to the after care program and charged accordingly.
9. The teacher has the right to ask a child to leave the activity if he or she is not demonstrating self-control or following directions. The child will remain in the classroom until the club is dismissed.
10. If you are paying with cash please take the cash and application form to the main office.
11. Payment for all tuition, supply fees and application fees MUST be payable to The Cushman School.

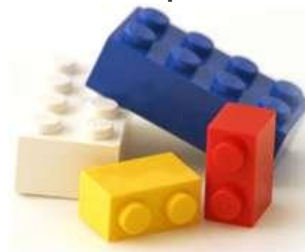


Lego Build and Take Home

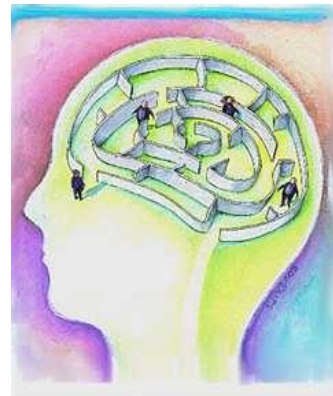
Odyssey of the Mind

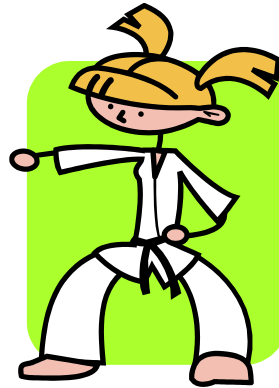


Karate

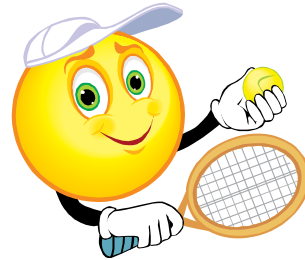

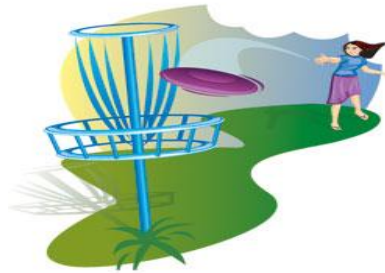

Cushman After School Club Policies

1. All clubs are on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is a limited amount of space in many clubs. Get your application in early.
2. Registration must be accompanied with the club tuition, supply fee and application fee in order to be enrolled.
3. Only one application fee is required per student regardless of the number of clubs he or she is attending in any club session.
4. Students must be enrolled by the first week (first day) of the club. Students registering after the deadline date may not be able to attend the first class.
5. Students registering after the due date will be charged a \$10.00 late fee.
6. If a student doesn't wish to continue to attend a club after the first meeting, he or she is entitled to a refund of TUITION only. Written notice must be submitted within two days after the first meeting or a refund will not be given.
7. Teachers will make up any club meetings they miss for days the school is closed or if the teacher is out of school. If the student misses a meeting, the teacher is not required to make up that day. If a student is absent from school on the day a club meets, they may not attend the club that day.
8. Students must be picked up promptly when clubs are finished or they will be sent to the after care program and charged accordingly.
9. The teacher has the right to ask a child to leave the activity if he or she is not demonstrating self-control or following directions. The child will remain in the classroom until the club is dismissed.
10. If you are paying with cash please take the cash and application form to the main office.
11. Payment for all tuition, supply fees and application fees MUST be payable to The Cushman School.
